Objective The primary objective of the workshop was to familiarize participants with:

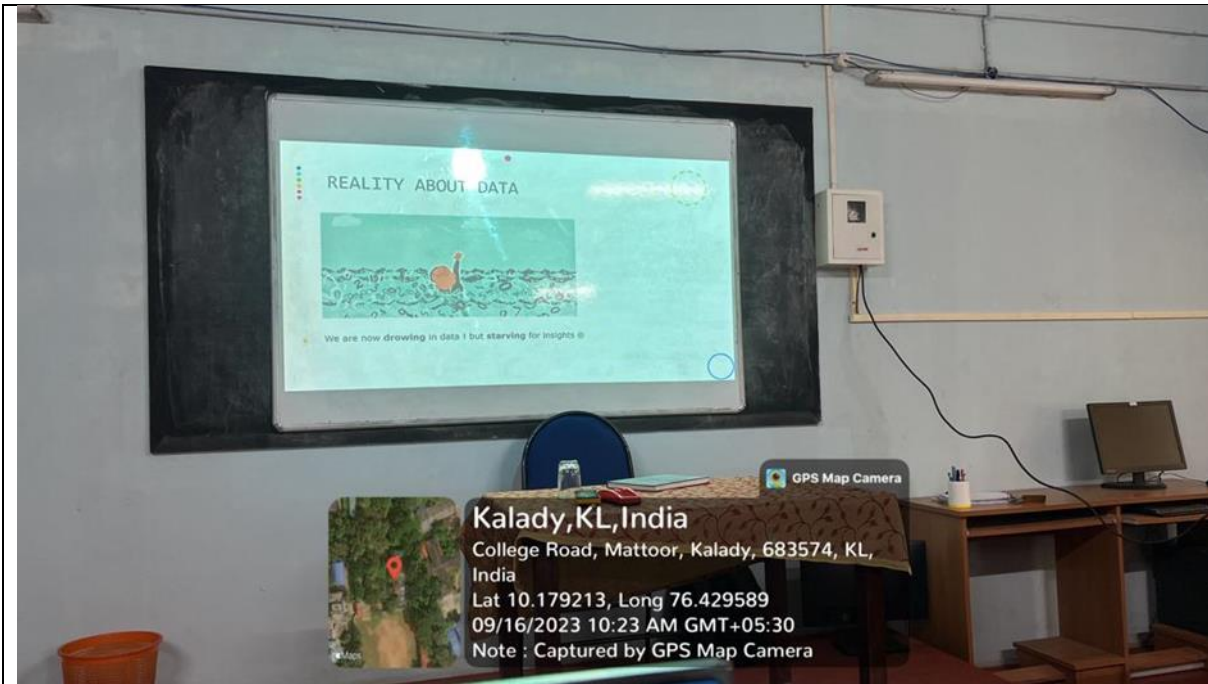
1. The core functionalities of Power BI.

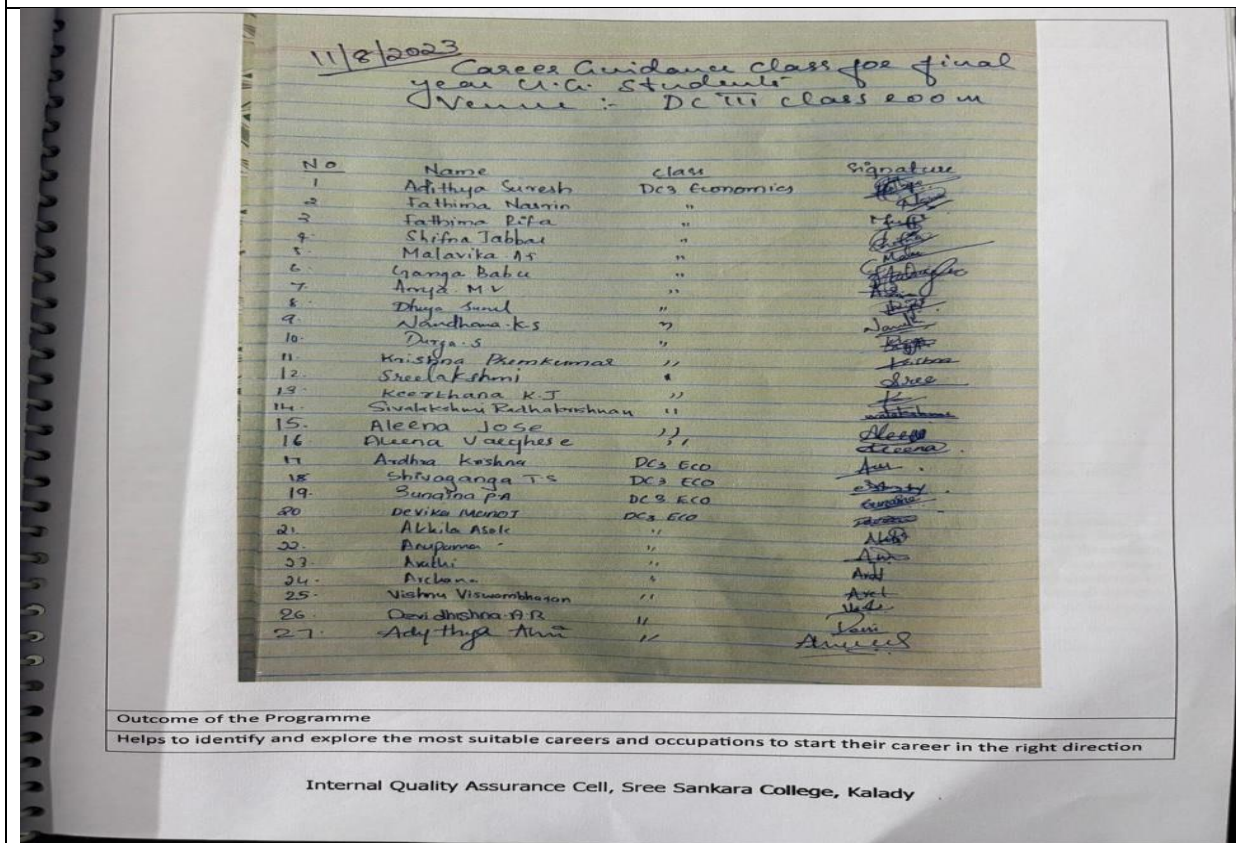

Report

The *Work Readiness Program* organized by the ASAP Community Skill Park, Perumbavoor, in collaboration with the Kerala Knowledge Economy Mission and the Higher Education Department of the Government of Kerala during 25/10/2023, 26/10/2023 and 28/10/2023, aimed to prepare candidates for job interviews and enhance their employability skills. 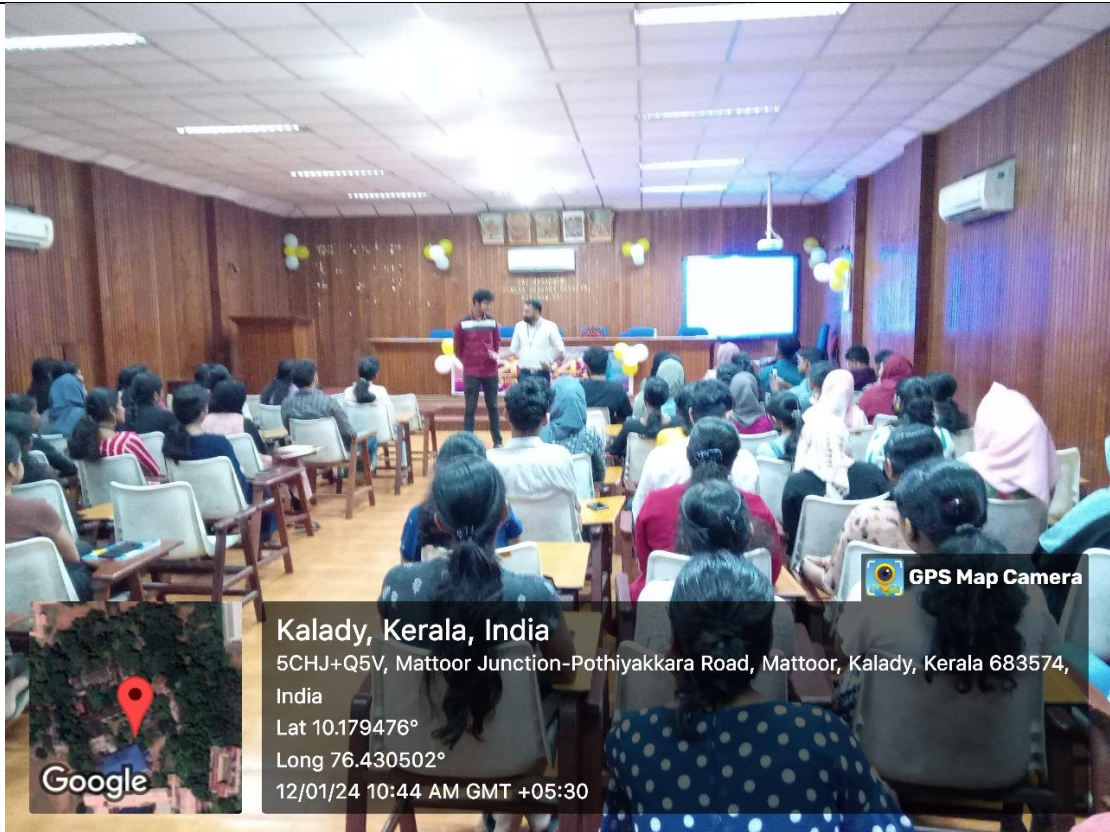

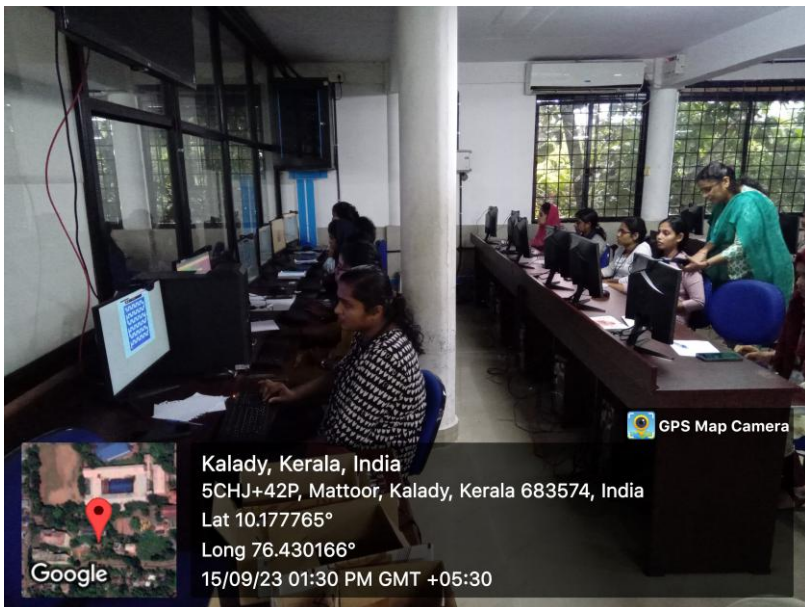


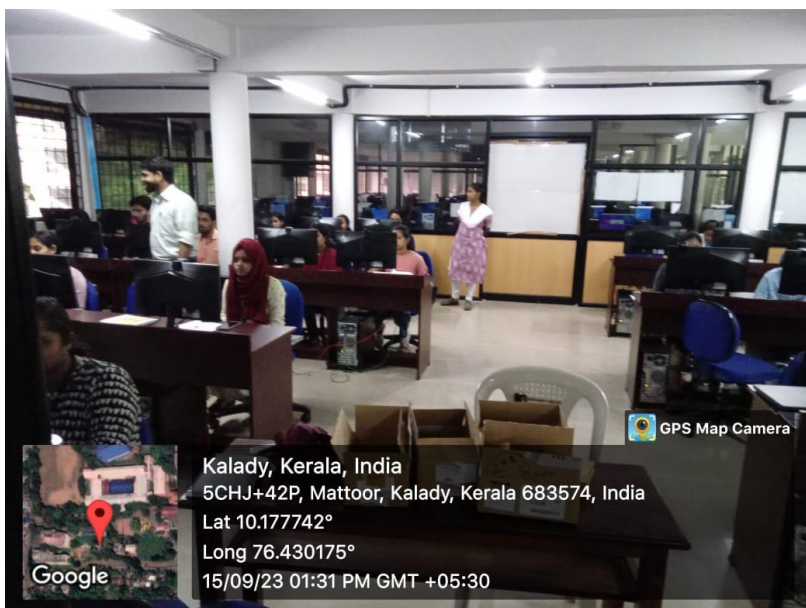
Preliminary Exam

identify candidates with the requisite knowledge and skills for further evaluation. From the pool of participants, six students successfully cleared the preliminary round and advanced to the interview stage.

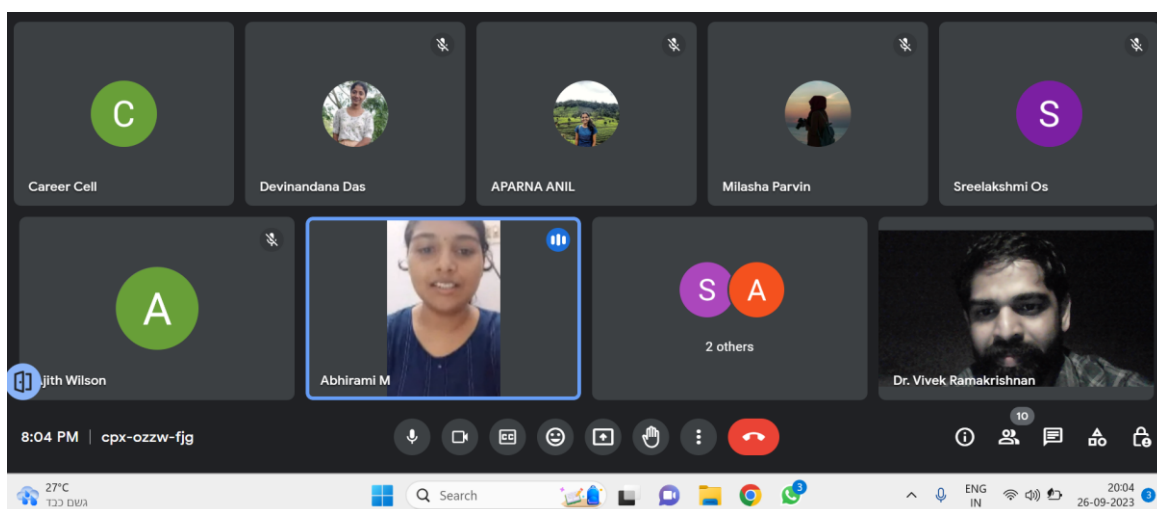






Career Guidance Session

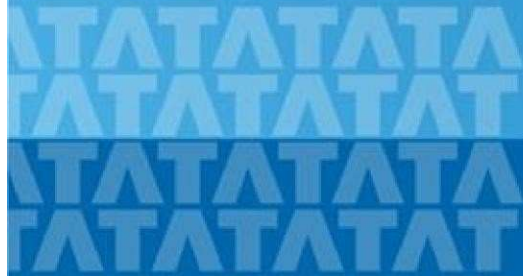
